Dear Licensee:

The above-referenced license is accepted for safekeeping, as provided by PLCB Regulation 7.31.

A license may be held in safekeeping for up to two consecutive years. Since your license was received for safekeeping on June 10, 2019, the two-year safekeeping period will expire on June 10, 2021.

It is the responsibility and obligation of the licensee to keep the license current throughout the safekeeping period by timely completing all regular renewals and validations.

Failure to release the license from safekeeping, or failure to transfer the license before the safekeeping period expires, will result in revocation of the license except in cases where circumstances beyond the licensee's control prevent reactivation. Every effort should be made to reactivate or transfer the license prior to June 10, 2021. If you have registered for a PLCB+ account, you will need to sign in and go under Other License Changes/Amendments to select the appropriate option when you are ready to act. If you have not registered, your access code to do so is 60229040.

To pursue extension of the safekeeping period for one additional year, a licensee must request an extension of safekeeping prior to June 10, 2021. Section 474.1(g) of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code, referenced in pertinent part below, and Act 39 of 2016, establishes the process and fees relative to pursuing safekeeping extension:

(1) "A licensee whose license is subject to this section may, upon request, apply to the Board to allow the license to remain in safekeeping for an additional one year. The written request must be accompanied by a \$10,000 filing fee for licenses placed in safekeeping from counties of the 1st class, 2nd class, 2nd class A, 3rd and 4th classes and a fee of \$5,000 for licenses placed in safekeeping from counties of the 5th through 8th classes. The Board shall approve the request unless the license or licensee no longer meets the requirements of this act or the Board's regulations."

Continued

(2) "A licensee whose license remains in safekeeping after the expiration of an approved additional one-year period may submit a written request for additional one-year periods; however, for each additional year thereafter, the safekeeping fee is doubled. For example, in class 1-4 counties, the fee is \$10,000 for year 3 in safekeeping, then \$20,000 for year 4, then \$40,000 for year 5, etc.
